# Speaker bio

Neil Pickering is a Chartered Occupational Hygienist (CFFOH) and a Chartered Safety Practitioner (CMIOSH) with 30 years experience in HS&E.

In nearly 27 years at Rolls-Royce (Aerospace) he progressed through to Company Occupational Hygienist

before switching to a wider HS&E role in the business that included two COMAH sites. Subsequent roles included Regional HS&E Director for North America, Head of H&S and Global Head of HS&E Services back in the UK.

For nearly 4 years Neil was the Group HS&E Director for JCB before setting up as an independent consultant. Neil chaired the MakeUK (EEF) OH&S Policy Committee for 9 years and has been actively involved with the British Occupational Hygiene Society including as Registrar for the Faculty of Occupational Hygiene and now chairing the Breathe Freely in Manufacturing campaign (focusing on welding). As a glutton for punishment he was also chair of Governors for the local primary school for 5 of his 7 years as a governor.
